REQUIRED HEALTH FORMS

WBF is proud to be a Massachusetts Licensed Camp. ALL campers are required to have the following on file BEFORE they can be left at our camp.

- 1. WBF Health and Waiver Form completely filled out and with ALL signatures.
- 2. A COPY OF YOUR CAMPER'S CURRENT PHYSICAL WITH IMMUNIZATION HISTORY

CAMP HOURS

8:30-12:30— DROP OFF STARTS AT 8:15 EXTENDED DAY- CAMP ENDS AT 4:30 CIT CAMPERS 8:00-4:00

f you are in one of our riding programs please be on time or early each day- we want to be sure campers are ready for their riding time which may vary each day. If a camper is late and misses their riding time it may not be able to be made up

DROP OFF PROCEDURE

<u>Monday-First day of camp</u>— please park your car and walk your child down to the main barn to check in. I know separating can be hard but please drop off as quickly as possible so we may begin our camp day! It is amazing how quickly the morning goes! ALL Paperwork and Payments must be submitted prior to your child being left at camp

Tuesday-Friday—Drop off is a loop - parents do not park or get out of car

Drive into the parking lot and make a loop to drop your camper off to the counselors. A counselor will be in the parking lot to direct traffic.

A counselor will greet your camper and help them out of the car!

Please have sun block and bug spray put on at home- not in the parking lot. Please do not park your car. We want to get our camp activities started so we appreciate an efficient drop off each day!

If you forgot something for your child please text our camp director, Nancy Dubin, 508-802-3649 to arrange to bring back the item(lunch, etc)

PICK UP PROCEDURE

Pick up is at 12:30 - Parents may begin lining up for pick up no earlier than 12:20. Drive into the parking lot and make a loop. <u>Counselors will bring your camper to you!</u> Parents do not get out of the car

There will be someone out there on the first day to help with directing cars.

Pick up for extended day is 4:30 you may park your car- counselors will be waiting at the red barn with campers <u>Please do not come early for pick up without prior notification to</u> the camp Director, Nancy Dubin.

WHAT TO WEAR for JUNIOR FARMERS

Dress for the farm to be outside, getting a little dirty and having some farm fun! Sturdy shoes are a must-sneakers & boots are perfect but NO sandals, clogs, mules, flip flops or ANY open toed shoes. Any child wearing unsafe shoes may be asked to sit out of some activities to ensure safety!

What to wear for SUMMER RIDERS AND TINY TROTTERS

Campers in our Summer Riding Camp and Tiny Trotters camp are required to have their own ASTM approved riding helmet in acceptable condition or new. Any other Helmets for biking or skiing will not be accepted for riding camp. If you bring your own helmet our staff will approve the first day of camp.

Campers will also need riding boots. We prefer them to be authentic riding boots for safety, proper learning and a successful riding experience!

NO RAIN, SNOW BOOTS OR FASHION BOOTS.

Long Pants will also be needed for riding! Riding pants or a light stretch pant. Campers may bring shorts To change into after riding. Campers may not ride in shorts, their legs will rub on the leather and become red ,sore.

LUNCH, SNACKS AND WATER

Campers have a morning snack time and lunch at 12:00.

Please have your camper bring—A snack, lunch and plenty of water!!! Lunches should be in a small cooler bag with an ice pack if needed.

We do not offer any food to campers and we discourage food sharing.

WE WOULD LIKE TO ASK THAT NO PEANUT FOODS BE SENT TO CAMP CONSIDERING THE WIDE RANGE OF PEANUT ALLERGIES.

WATER PLEASE SEND YOUR CAMPER WITH PLENTY OF WATER, THE KIDS ARE VERY BUSY AND GET VERY THIRSTY AND HOT.

CAMP IS ONLY FOR THE MORNING AND KIDS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN THINGS, SO PLEASE DO NOT PACK EXTRA CLOTHES AND SUCH IN A HEAVY BACKPACK....LESS IS MORE!!!

"On the Farm" extended afternoon session-if added

Pick-up for the extended afternoon session is at 4:30. Please be on time for pick up.

Late camper pick up fee- Parents arriving late will be charged an additional fee to cover staffing.

10 mins past pick up time will be charged a \$10 late fee

20 mins or great will be a \$15 late fee

Please send your camper with extra snacks, water, and extra clothes if needed. For the last day of camp for our riding students in extended day, we would still like them to ride for parents at 11:30 with the other kids- let us know if this is possible for a parent to be there.

Campers may walk to the park ,Pizza, ice cream store or Fiskes for Candy.
Parents will be notified so they may send their camper with a small amount of money.
You may also pack flip flops, bathing suit and a towel for water games/activities. counselors will give campers an idea of their schedule for extended day on Monday.

Riding students will wish to change out of riding boots and clothes so please pack a change of clothes and comfortable shoes

WE WILL BE ENCOURAGING HAND SANITIZING, AVID WATER DRINKING DURING THE DAY AND GOOD LISTENING SKILLS, PLEASE DISCUSS THE IMPORTANCE OF THESE WITH YOUR CHILD.
